# Our Part In Our Maturity

Ephesians Series Part 13 Ephesians 4:17-31

<sup>17</sup> *With the Lord's authority I say this: **Live no longer as the Gentiles do**.....*

The Bible was written to be \_\_\_\_\_, and not simply studied or heard! (James 1:22)

Paul was saying, "Here is what Christ has done for you, so, here is what we ought to do for Christ."

>The fact that we have been called in Christ (Eph. 1:18) ought to motivate us to walk in \_\_\_\_\_! (4:1–16).

>The fact that we have been raised from the dead (2:1–10) should motivate us to walk in \_\_\_\_\_! (4:17–5:17).

## 1. The Admonition 17-19

<sup>17</sup> *With the Lord's authority I say this: Live no longer as the Gentiles do, for they are **hopelessly confused**.<sup>18</sup> Their minds are full of darkness; they wander far from the life God gives because they have closed their minds and hardened their hearts against Him.<sup>19</sup> They have no sense of shame. They live for lustful pleasure and eagerly practice every kind of impurity.*

We should **LIVE** Differently because we \_\_\_\_\_ Differently!

## 2. The Argument 20-24

<sup>20</sup> **But you have not so learned Christ** [NKJV]

<sup>21</sup> *Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the truth that comes from Him,* <sup>22</sup> *throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception.*

<sup>23</sup> *Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes.*

<sup>24</sup> *Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.*

## 3. The Application 25-32

<sup>25</sup> *So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body.*<sup>26</sup> *And "don't sin by letting anger control you." Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry,*<sup>27</sup> *for anger gives a foothold to the devil.* <sup>28</sup> *If you are a thief, quit stealing. Instead, use your hands for good hard work, and then give generously to others in need.* <sup>29</sup> *Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.*<sup>30</sup> **And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live**. Remember, He has identified you as His own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.<sup>31</sup> *Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior.* <sup>32</sup> *Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.*
