

1. ABOUT GOD

Gen. 1:1,26,27, 3:22; Ps. 90:2; Matt. 28:19; 1 Pet. 1:2; 2 Cor. 13:14


- God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe.

- These three are co-equal and are one God.

2. ABOUT JESUS CHRIST

Matt. 1:22,23; Is. 9:6; John 1:1-5, 14:10-13; Heb. 4:14,15; 1 Cor. 15:3,4;
Rom. 1:3,4; Acts 1:9-11; Colossians 1:15-16; 1 Tim. 6:14,15

- Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father.

- Jesus lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all people by dying on a cross.
- He arose from the dead after three days to demonstrate His power over sin and death.

3. ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

2 Cor. 3:17; John 16:7-13, 14:16,17; Acts 1:8;
Eph. 1:13, 5:18; Gal. 5:25.

- The Holy Spirit is co-equal with the Father and the Son of God.
- He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ.
- He also lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation.
- He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right.
- He gives every believer a spiritual gift when they are saved. As Christians we seek to live under His control daily.

4. ABOUT THE BIBLE

2 Tim. 3:16, 1:13; 2 Pet. 1:20,21; Ps. 119:105,16; 12:6; Prov. 30:5


- The Bible is God's Word to us.

5. ABOUT HUMAN BEINGS

Gen. 1:27; Ps. 8:3-6; Is. 53:6a, 59:1,2; Rom. 3:23.

- People are made in the spiritual image of God, to be like Him in character and are the supreme object of God's creation
- Although every person has tremendous potential for good, all of us are marred by an attitude of disobedience toward God called "sin". This attitude separates people from God and causes many problems in life.



6. ABOUT SALVATION

Rom. 6:23, 5:1; Eph. 2:8,9; John 14:6, 1:12, Titus 3:5; Gal. 3:26.

- Salvation is God's free gift to us but we must accept it.
- We can never make up for our sin by _____ or good works.
- Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness can anyone be saved from sin's penalty.
- When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith we are saved.
- Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith.

7. ABOUT ETERNAL SECURITY

John 10:28,29; 2 Tim. 1:12; Heb. 7:25, 10:10,14; 1 Pet. 1:3-5

- Because God gives us eternal life through Jesus Christ, the true believer is secure in that salvation for eternity. If you have been genuinely saved, you cannot "lose" it.
- Salvation is maintained by the grace and power of God, not by the self-effort of the Christian. It is the grace and _____ of God that gives us this security.



8. ABOUT ETERNITY

John 3:16, 2:25, 5:11-13; Rom. 6:23; Rev. 20:15; Matt. 1:8, 2:44,46.

- People were created to exist forever.
 - We will either exist eternally separated from God by sin, or eternally with God through forgiveness and salvation.

- To be eternally separated from God is Hell.
 - To be eternally in union with Him is eternal life.
- Heaven and Hell are _____ of eternal existence.
