Pray for the Lost

Hearts to be receptive

For God, who said, “Let there be light in the darkness,” has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:6

Ears to be open

So I want you to know that this salvation from God has also been offered to the Gentiles, and they will listen to it. Acts 28:28

Attitudes to be changed

So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace. Romans 8:6

Repentance to occur

Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. Acts 3:19
